- Standardized, both norm-referenced and criterion-referenced.
- Computer adaptive testing format completed by caregiver.
- Age Range: Birth to 20 years.
- The PEDI-CAT measures abilities in four functional domains: Daily Activities, Mobility and Social/Cognitive, and Responsibility.
- Efficient and customizable for different needs.

Roll Evaluation of Activities of Life (REAL)

Kristin Roll, William Roll

- Standardized, criterion-referenced.
- Pencil and paper rating forms/checklist completed by caregiver.
- Age Range: 2 years to 18 years 11 months.
- Assesses children's ability to perform Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) and Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADLs) in settings such as home, school, and community.
- Useful for determining needs for support and tracking functional skill development.

- Standardized, norm-referenced.
- Interview, Parent/Caregiver Rating Form, Teacher Rating Form.
- Age range: Birth to 90+ years old.
- Vineland-3 assesses adaptive behavior in communication, daily living skills, and socialization.
- Helps determine how an individual manages real-life demands.
