BAYLEY SCALES OF INFANT AND TODDLER DEVELOPMENT

Nancy Bayley

- Norm-referenced, formal assessment for determining developmental delays in children
- Paper or Q-global (Digital) Administration, examiner-administrated assessment and caregiver questionnaires
- 16 days to 42 months
- Assesses adaptive behavior, cognitive, language, motor, and social-emotional domains

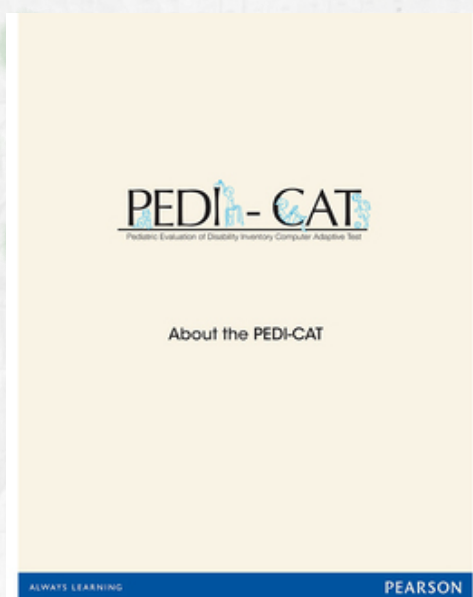
MILLER FUNCTION AND PARTICIPATION SCALES (M-FUN)

Lucy J. Miller

- Standardized assessment
- Workbooks for 2 different age ranges including writing, drawing, tracing, and cutting activities, as well as observation checklists for home and classroom settings
- 2 years to 7 years 11 months
- Assesses functional performance of children related to school participation

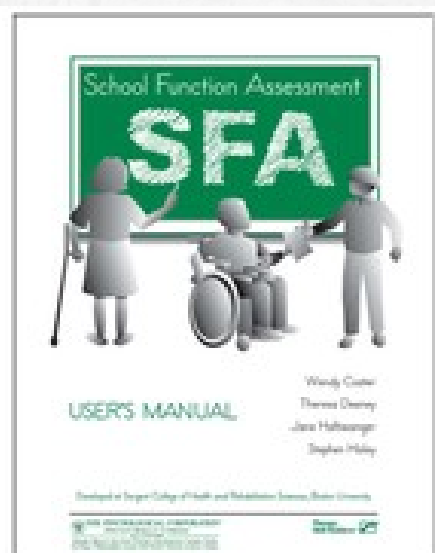

SCHOOL FUNCTION ASSESSMENT (SFA)

Wendy Coster, Theresa Deeney, Jane Haltiwanger, Stephen Haley

- Standardized assessment, criterion-referenced
- Judgement-based questionnaire completed by school professionals rating participation, task supports, and activity performance
- 6 to 12 years old (Kindergarten through 6th grade)
- Assesses student strengths and limitations for school-related functional tasks
