- Standardized assessment, norm-referenced
 - Rating scale (parent, teacher, caregiver, or self-report for adults), printed or online forms available
 - 4 months to 87 years old
 - Assesses sensory integration and processing including visual, auditory, tactile, olfactory, gustatory, proprioceptive, and vestibular systems in various environments

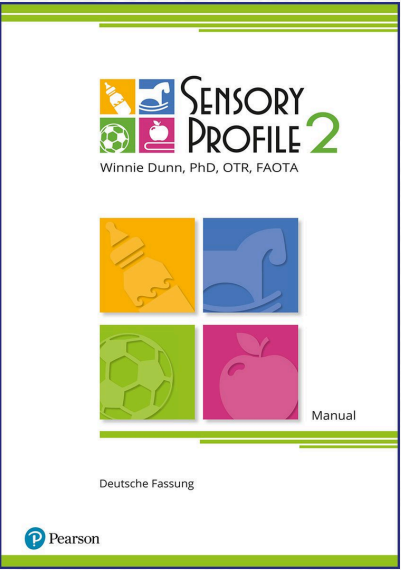
SENSORY PROFILE 2

Winnie Dunn

- Standardized assessment, norm-referenced
- Paper or online administration through questionnaire for caregivers and teachers using a 5-point Likert scale
- Birth to 14 years old (infant, toddler, child, and school companion forms)
- Assesses auditory, visual, touch, movement, body position, oral sensory, conduct, social emotional, and attentional through 4 quadrants (Seeking/Seeker, Avoiding/Avoider, Sensitivity/Sensor, and Registration/Bystander)

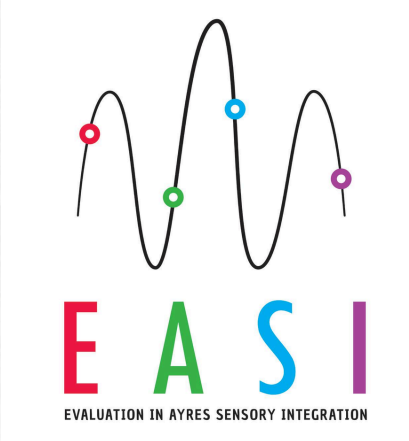
SENSORY INTEGRATION AND PRAXIS TEST (SIPT)

A Jean Ayres

- Standardized assessment, norm-referenced
- Computer-scored; 17 tasks can be administered together or individually
- 4 years to 8 years 11 months
- Assesses visual perception, tactile perception, somatosensory, praxis, and sensorimotor

- Focused on sensory perception, sensory reactivity, postural, ocular, bilateral motor integration, and praxis
